On November 27, the International Forum BIT-2024 was held in Tbilisi. The event brought together the IT community of the capital of Georgia and other regions of the country. Traditionally for the past few years, the forum was held in a hybrid format: offline + online.

In first speech, Vladimir Ivlev, Regional Manager – CIS, Grandstream Networks Inc., spoke about the trends in the development of wireless Wi-Fi networks and introduced forum participants to the company's equipment for building wireless networks of various sizes.



Maxim Prakhov, Regional Sales Director Central Asia, Caucasus, presented the FUDO PAM (Privileged Access Management) solution, which monitors, controls and records privileged access sessions to the IT infrastructure.

Davit Archvadze, Head of Cyber Security Solutions, Noventiq Georgia, and Maksym Kurskoi, ESET Senior Technical Specialist in Central Asia, Armenia, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine, presented modern ESET technologies and solutions for powerful comprehensive business protection.

Levan Nadiradze, Independent Consultant, Kingston Technology, gave a presentation on “Kingston Technology: data security and modern storage devices”.

Serhii Shapovalov, Regional Director, Takopi Georgia, presented modern networking solutions for business applications from vendors such as Netgear, Mikrotik and Sophos.

In the following presentation, Victoria Abed, Chief Revenue Officer at Pitchavatar.com, presented 10 different scenarios where AI avatars would do a better job than real employees.



Guram Lemonjava, General Director Encos, and Mikhail Zolotarev, Deputy director Encos, gave a presentation on “Racks, a CRAC and two smoking diesel engines... basic infrastructure requirements for real-life mission-critical IT systems”.

David Gyulnazaryan, Independent Consultant, Impleon, spoke about how open-source data centers help with environmental and social aspects.

In addition to interesting and challenging presentations, participants were able to visit an exhibition of the latest achievements in the ICT market and communicate with representatives of the following companies: ESET, Noventiq Georgia, FUDO Security, IT Oberig, Grandstream Networks, MUK, Kingston Technology, Encos, Smart Network Georgia, Takopi Georgia, Netgear, Mikrotik, Sophos.
